## COST OF PEACE - KEEPING

The United States of America has stated that it is prepared to contribute \$2.4 million towards the cost of maintaining UNFICYP for the present mandate.

The government however reserves the right to "make such adjustments in the level of its payments against this pledge as it may deem appropriate dependant upon confirmation of the Secretary-General's cost estimates and on an adequate level of contributions being made by other governments towards the cost of the operation". Ambassador Bennett in a recent statement at the Security Council said that the United States is presently consulting with other interested governments in an effort to work out a joint approach which would eliminate the

UNFICYP deficit and place future UNFICYP financing on a sound and sustainable basis. He felt that some progress was being made in these negotiations and thanked the Secretary-General for his continued efforts in this regard



Självfallet var det den stora svenska seger som också värmde i varje blå-gult hjärta. Nog hade väl många på förhand gått och hoppats på en hyfsad svensk insats men att vi skulle leda loppet från början till slut och segra med 38 sekunder före andra laget hade nog ingen drömt om.

Så blev det nu i alla fall och även om det känns lite ofint att arrangören tar hem segeren så var det ju en härlig seger. Sveriges andra lag kunde däremot inte hångna med riktigt i mitten av loppet men kämpade sig på slutet upp till en femteplats-två minuter efter det segrande laget.

De som stod på campen hade också stor glädje av it Lars Herrstedts förträffliga referande av loppet. Hans egen hejarklack för de svenska löparna gick också hem hos publiken - i synnerhet den svenska. Efter fullföljt lopp fick deltagarna varm dryck och den militärmusikkår som 1. Irish Rangers ställde upp med spelade avspänd promenadmusik. Ja det hela var rörande idylliskt. Så följde prisutdelning som förrättades av kontingentchefen Ingemar Bondeson. De tre bästa lagen mot tog priserna uppställda på HF-plannen och publiken applåderade livligt. 



**IRCON'S PERSONALITY OF THE WEEK**





## KUVASATOA VIIME SUNNUNTAIN OPINTOMATKALTA

Huomattavin Kyproksen muinaisristilauteen on Khirokitiassa Limassolin tien varrella. Se on myöhäiskivikauden asutuskeskus, joka on rakennettu n. 7500-8000 vuoden sitten rakennettuun, nykyisin täysin raunioituneeseen Curiumin kaupunkiin. (kuva alhaalla oikealla)

Limassolin seudun hedelmäviljelijöiden läpi ajettiin kilometrejä pitkää syppressikujaa pitkin. Tässä levensetyllyä tieosuudella aurinkokin pilkisti tielle niin paljon, että innokkaimmat kuvajaat sattoivat ikuisista tämän ainutlaatuiseen koekumukseen. (kuva alhaalla vasemmalta)

Kun saaren omistus oli kolmannen ristiretken jälkeen v.1192 siirtynyt fankkilaisruhtinaiden omistukseen, nämä rakensivat myöhemmin Limassolin alueelle komean linnan, Kolossin, jonka mahtavia muotoja retkeläiset tällä kertaa katselivat vain ulkopuolisesti. Linnaan tutustutaan sisältäpäin 19.3. Paphoksen tehtävän retken yhteydessä. Kolossin jälkeen viimesunnuntainen opintomatka suuntautui 800 v. liin rakennettuun Apollon temppeliin.

# SWEDCON DID IT AGAIN


